## TROLLKIRKA — (Troll Church, cave – 494 m.ü.M)





Why do we recommend this trip?

The so-called Troll Church consists of three exciting limestone caves with underground streams and waterfalls. The bottom two have beautiful 14m waterfalls that end in a white marble pool. The upper one essentially consists of long underground passages. At the height, west of the upper cave, is a lake with white marble banks. What is special about the mountain formation behind the Troll Church are the spikes and peaks. If you want to experience this natural setting, you should put on rubber boots / good hiking shoes and insert a flashlight. From a sign posted car park on Rv 64, you can get there on a steep path in about 120 minutes.
